BRIDGING THE CLASSROOM TO THE REAL WORLD

Astronomers Capture Two Black Holes in Orbit: A First in Cosmic History

Astronomers have, for the first time, captured a radio image of two supermassive black holes orbiting each other inside the quasar OJ287, about 5 billion light-years away. This discovery confirms a long-held theory about binary black holes and provides visual proof of their orbital interaction. The black holes were detected not through light, but by observing their surrounding particle jets and glowing gases using Earth-based radio telescopes and the Russian space telescope RadioAstron.

Key Features:

- **Historic Discovery:** First radio image of two orbiting supermassive black holes.
- **Scientific Significance:** Validates century-old predictions about quasars.
- **Technological Breakthrough:** Achieved through advanced radio astronomy collaboration.

For IB Physics learners, this milestone illustrates gravitational theory and the effects of relativity near black holes. For Environmental Systems and Computer Science learners, it showcases the intersection of data modelling, light behavior, and astrophysical observation.

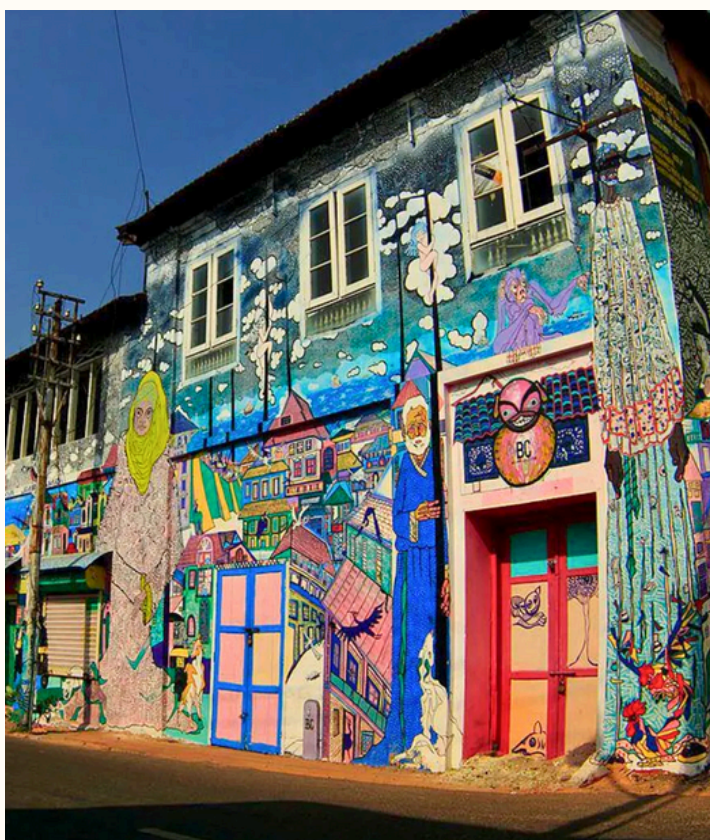

India's Art Market Breaks Records, Fuelling a Cultural Renaissance

India's art market is booming, with record-breaking auctions and rising interest from collectors worldwide. A recent Saffronart auction in Delhi fetched \$40.2 million, with Vasudeo Santu Gaitonde's Untitled (1971) selling for \$7.57 million — nearly triple its estimate.

Key Highlights:

- **Growth:** Market valued at \$338M, projected to reach \$1.1B by 2030.
- **Global Demand:** Diaspora collectors fuel interest in heritage.
- **Opportunities:** Galleries, museums, and fairs like India Art Fair and Kochi-Muziris Biennale attract worldwide attention.

- Adjust study strategies and plan for upcoming assessments.

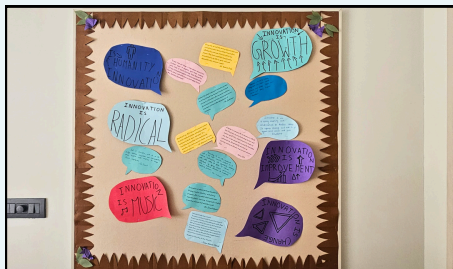


Checklist for DP2 Learners

By reflecting on performance and staying focused, learners can approach the remainder of the term with clarity and purpose – building momentum for academic success and a strong foundation for the future.

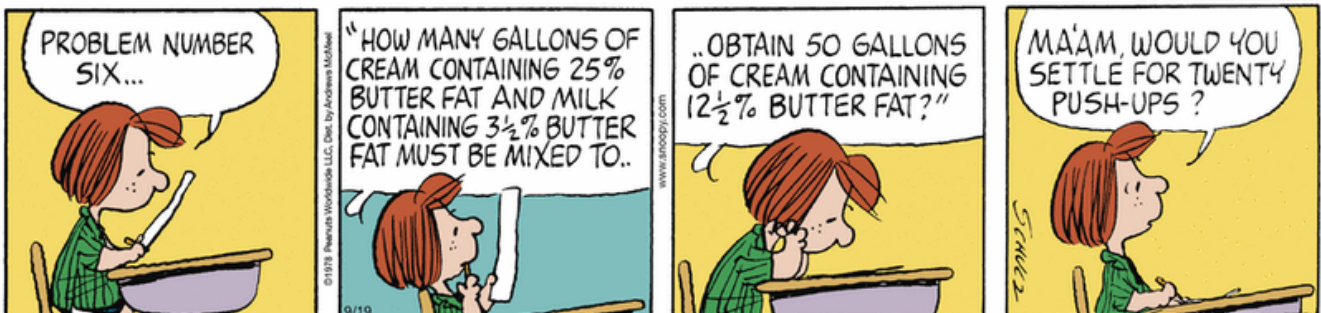
