Quantum Computing Roadmaps: The Race to Revolutionary Computing Power

Major technology companies, including IBM, Google, Microsoft, and Amazon, are developing quantum computers that solve complex problems far faster than classical computers. Key developments include:

- IBM aims to launch a quantum-centric supercomputer by 2025 with over 4,000 qubits
- Google targets error-corrected quantum computing by 2029
- Microsoft is pursuing scalable topological qubits

IB learners study algorithms and computational thinking: core topics that provide foundations for quantum technologies, offering real-world examples of cutting-edge innovation.

FOCAL LENS - A VISUAL ARTS DIRECTIVE

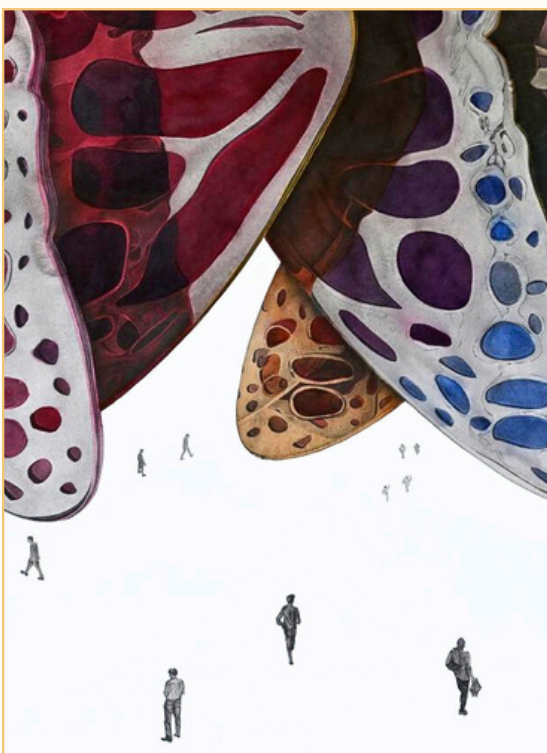

Metamorphosis: Exploring Transformation Through Visual Art

Visual artist Phaneendra Nath Chaturvedi's exhibition *Metamorphosis* presented 59 artworks exploring transformation and duality. Key highlights include:

- Drew inspiration from Varanasi, capturing the ancient city's paradoxes
- Featured human-like figures caught between species and eras
- Used butterflies as symbols representing resilience and transcendence
- Employed mixed-media techniques across paper, steel, and fibreglass

This exhibition demonstrated how personal narrative informed artistic practice. Chaturvedi's symbolic use of butterflies illustrated how artists communicate complex ideas through visual language.
