### Annual Sports Day at Knowledgeum Academy

The Annual Sports Day at Knowledgeum Academy unfolded as a vibrant celebration of teamwork, discipline, and sporting spirit, brought together through seamless coordination and student leadership. Held on 30th January, the day commenced with an official oath, followed by a clear briefing on the agenda led by the Student Council, setting expectations and ensuring a smooth flow into the competitive sessions ahead. Throughout the day, the council played a pivotal role by offering timely updates, enabling efficient transitions between events, and maintaining high energy across the grounds.



Ahead of lunch, the Fitness Challenge—featuring sprints and relay formats—served as a dynamic midpoint, sustaining momentum and encouraging endurance, agility, and sportsmanship. Post-lunch sessions transitioned into Badminton and Pickleball, with both singles and doubles categories offering fast-paced, competitive play and strategic teamwork.

The sporting events concluded on a warm and inclusive note with a friendly exhibition match featuring the Teaching Staff, fostering positive faculty–student interaction beyond the competitive arena. The day culminated in a comprehensive awards ceremony, where medals and certificates were presented for the day’s finals as well as earlier indoor events, including Chess and Table Tennis, bringing the Annual Sports Day to a fitting close, marked by celebration, recognition, and collective pride.

## Republic Day Celebration 2026 At Knowledgeum Academy



The Republic Day Celebration was held on 26th January 2026 at Knowledgeum Academy, marking the occasion with a thoughtful blend of national pride, academic reflection and community participation. The programme commenced with the solemn hoisting of the National Flag and the rendition of the National Anthem, followed by the reading of the Preamble and the pledge led by Head Boy Daksh Jain and Head Girl Harshitha, setting a respectful and patriotic tone for the day.

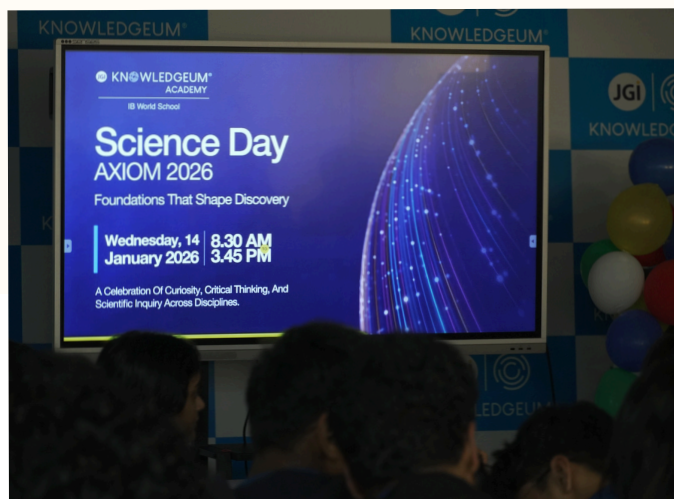

# AXIOM 2026

## Science Day Celebration

On 14th January 2026, Knowledgeum Academy celebrated Science Day through AXIOM 2026, a day-long academic and experiential event held at the Knowledgeum Academy Auditorium. Designed to spark curiosity and intellectual engagement, the celebration highlighted science as a discipline deeply intertwined with culture, everyday life and human progress. The programme opened with a cultural presentation titled “Makar Sankranti: When Science Changes Direction,” which explored scientific concepts such as the Earth’s axial tilt and solar movement through the lens of cultural traditions. This was followed by interactive segments including The Science Behind the Magic and a competitive Science Quiz, encouraging inquiry and analytical thinking.



A short film screening, Reality Check – Science Did It First, further reinforced the relevance of scientific thinking by creatively connecting science to real-world innovations.



Post-lunch sessions featured engaging activities such as Myth Busters and the Science Memory Match Game, leading into the Collaborative Science Project (CSP) Presentations. These presentations showcased learners’ interdisciplinary thinking, ethical reflection and collaborative skills, and were evaluated by Dr. Asha Rajiv and Mr. Kalai Rajan. The event concluded with a closing ceremony and prize distribution, bringing AXIOM 2026 to a meaningful close and leaving learners with a deeper appreciation for science as a dynamic and human endeavour.

## Exam Season Playbook



As assessment season draws closer, learners are sharing what's helping them stay focused, balanced and confident during revision:

- Plan with intention – Structuring revision into realistic blocks helps avoid burnout and keeps preparation steady rather than rushed.
- Engage with feedback – Revisiting teacher comments and past assessments is proving just as valuable as learning new content.
- Practise with purpose – Past papers and sample questions are being used to understand command terms, answer structure and time management.
- Make learning active – Summarising concepts, creating visual organisers and discussing ideas with peers are helping reinforce understanding.
- Stay grounded – Maintaining routines around sleep, nutrition and movement is supporting focus, memory and overall wellbeing.
- Reflect and reset – Checking progress regularly allows learners to adjust strategies calmly instead of relying on last-minute revision.

Examinations, after all, are not just about remembering information, but about applying learning with clarity, confidence and purpose.
